Emergency Protocols for Water Leaks

In an emergency:

- 1. Report issue directly to Facilities Dispatch 970-491-0077.
- 2. Turn off electronics and move stuff out of the way and report issue.
- 3. Tarp what you cannot move out of the way or is particularly water sensitive.
- 4. Source tarps from Chemistry B115B and/or Chemistry Research 102aa (receiving).
- 5. Report to PI. If leak is affecting neighboring labs, reach out via cell. PI should inform Chair via cell.
- 6. Triage remaining items by (1) safety consideration and (2) cost/time to repair.
- 7. Report issue to Diane Garcia for follow-up. 970-491-0502, diane.garcia@colostate.edu
- 8. Clean and return tarps to original locations once leak is taken care of.

Non-emergencies:

1. Report to Diane Garcia, assistant building proctor.

Proactive options:

- 1. Consider covering any sensitive/unmovable equipment when not in use as the normal routine.
 - a. Tarps available in Chemistry B115B or Chemistry Research 102aa.
- 2. Regularly discuss lab protocols with group to ensure everyone is aware of the routine, emergency communication lists are created and shared, and modify protocols as needed.
